The Mecosta-Osceola ISD's Ashmun School at Eagle Village facility is seeking proposals for a replacement telephone system.

The system will replace a Lucent Partner II system and should include a PBX, voice mail, backup power, system software backup and phone sets.

The PBX must interface to existing POTS lines and the existing Eagle Village phone system system. The vendor will be responsible for the purchase of all equipment and all work performed.

The Ashmun School is an educational facility operated by the Mecosta-Osceola ISD and is housed within the Eagle Village facility.

There are several existing POTS lines. Vendor recommendations as to the number of POTS lines necessary are sought. There is need for 12 hand sets, minimum. The voice mail should be capable of 100 users.

A site survey and Q/A walk through will take place on 2 Jan, 2009. All interested vendors must attend as this will happen only once.

This project will be funded through the E-Rate program. Vendors must be certified by USAC and have a valid SPIN.

Proposals must include a detailed equipment list with make, model, price and a work time-line.

The deadline for proposals is 23 January 2009 at 3:00.
