DESCRIPTION: Employment as a teacher of Applied and Integrated Mathematics at the Mecosta-Osceola Intermediate School District Career & Technical Education Center

QUALIFICATIONS: Possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree and valid Secondary Highly Qualified Teaching credentials in Mathematics as issued by the State of Michigan. Experience in business or industry and the ability to relate to multiple areas of disciplines preferred. Credentials to meet requirements for the State of Michigan secondary teacher certification with vocational education teaching endorsement preferred. The preferred candidate must have a high level of enthusiasm and the ability to effectively work in a team as well as with students. Strong communication skills and creativity are required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Collaborate with all MOCC programs to create and implement integrated mathematics curriculum that naturally aligns to the state CTE segments. Assist instructors and students with the transition process and provide a team teaching approach to connect student to mathematics in contextual and applied ways.
2. Monitor ALL student progress in the 4th Year Math CTE Math class. Develop new ways to successfully incorporate mathematics into the CTE delivery model.
3. Plan and supervise work of students, individually or in small groups, in classroom, laboratory, and the Student Learning Center.
4. Collaborate with the Work-Based Learning Center/Student Learning Center Staff to provide student-centered training programs.
5. Test, evaluate, track, and monitor achievement of students in technical knowledge and trade skills as they relate to mathematics.
6. Work with administration and MOCC instructors to annually review program content as well as continuously revise curriculum to meet state and national vocational guidelines and align curriculum to academic frameworks.
7. Perform all general instructional duties including: purchasing of equipment and supplies; individualized instruction for students as needed; and completion of all necessary school reports.
8. Communicate with LEAs, Counselors, and other Regional CTE Math Instructors to stay abreast of trends in contextual learning and best practices in both general education and CTE.
