

Additional State of Michigan Requirements

Social Studies – 3 credits
Physical Education & Health – 1 credit
World Languages – 2 credits

Additional requirements may be mandated by individual school districts.

What is Articulation?

Receive credit for competencies mastered outside the classroom

Begin college in classes higher than entry level

Transfer community college credits to replace the general education requirements of a four-year university

Transfer lower level program course work programmatically to the four year university rather than transferring as elective credit

Articulation agreements are formal, written documents agreed upon by two or more institutions.

Eligible Colleges and Universities

All of the Mecosta-Osceola Career Center programs are eligible and have articulation agreements with **Ferris State University** and **Davenport College**.

Select programs also have articulation agreements with **Mid Michigan Community College**, **West Shore Community College**, **Baker College**, and **Kalamazoo Valley Community College**.
