MOP Co-Op Data Coach

DESCRIPTION:

The Data Coach will work under the supervision of the Director of General Education providing service to Mecosta-Osceola Intermediate School District and the local districts by focusing on extracting, gathering, coordinating, entering, managing and directing the use of data to help districts solve their academic puzzles.

REQUIREMENTS:

Minimum of a Bachelors Degree. Extensive database manipulation and query experience. Needs to be accomplished in Microsoft, Excel, Word and PowerPoint.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Report to MOISD's Director of General Education on the progress, need for assistance, and/or outcomes achieved from data management.
- 2. Report to principals, curriculum and special education directors on data gathered from Easy IEP, Pearson, MEAP, DIBELS, Accelerated Reader, etc. in order to assist districts in educational decision making.
- 3. Work to increase the value and power of the Pearson D.A.T.A. project for the local school districts.
- 4. Support local administration in the analysis and dissemination of data when requested. This will include curriculum, administration, staff and board meetings to explain, highlight or reinforce findings.
- 5. Must have excellent communications skills, both written and verbal.
- 6. Maintain a cooperative, harmonious relationship with professionals and others within the school setting.
- 7. Must have a valid driver's license and assume responsibility to transport self to assigned worksites.
- 8. Regular and predictable attendance.
- 9. Pursuant to "School Safety" legislation (2005 PA 129-131 and 138) enacted into law January 1, 2006, must pass a criminal history background investigation conducted by the Michigan State Police and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 10. Other duties as assigned by the General Education Director, Superintendent or designee.
