MOP Co-Op Maintenance (HVAC/Plumbing)

DESCRIPTION:

Employment as a Maintenance (HVAC/Plumbing) employee providing service to multiple districts within the Mecosta-Osceola ISD.

REQUIREMENTS:

High school diploma or GED. Valid Michigan driver's license. HVAC/Plumbing certification.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Maintain and perform preventive maintenance on controls and related equipment; adjust and calibrate equipment when necessary.
- 2. Respond to complaints regarding HVAC equipment and adjust or repair where necessary.
- 3. Perform minor electrical and pipefitting repairs to HVAC systems.
- 4. Check and maintain safe and efficient operations of high-pressure boilers and related equipment including air compressors, water pumps, fuel pumps, air conditioning equipment, boilers and automatic emergency lighting.
- 5. Monitor gauges and computer printout of machine performance; tend oiler controls and gauges; adjust or repair broken and worn parts. Periodically clean and overhaul boilers. Set and adjust controls to achieve desired performance.
- 6. Check, repair or replace valves and controls to maintain piping system.
- 7. Periodically check water conditions with test equipment and add conditioning chemicals as required.
- 8. Maintain required school district records of boiler room operations. Set up, check and replace recording charts and tapes. Maintain log operations by shift.
- 9. Organize time, energy and workload in order to meet responsibilities and complete assignments with due consideration of priorities among various responsibilities.
- 10. Assume responsibility to transport self to assigned worksite(s) and maintain regular and predictable attendance.
- 11. Perform other related duties as assigned by Supervisor or his/her designee.
