The Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) is made up of parents of children who receive special education services. This includes a wide range of children - from those who receive supports and services within a general education setting, to students enrolled in center-based programs.

The purpose of the MOISD PAC is to represent the views of parents with children who receive special education services. The PAC provides input at the ISD level, with a focus on the ISD Plan for Special Education Services.

Regular meetings are held the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of September, November, January, March and May at 9 a.m. Meetings are open to the public but only appointed representatives are allowed to make motions and vote. It is very important for PAC members to attend meetings regularly.

Each ISD is required to have a Parent Advisory Committee, according to Michigan Special Education Rule 340.1838.
