Preference may be given to applicants with a Bachelor's Degree from a certified or accredited educational institute with intensive course work in personal computers.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Troubleshoot, diagnose, repair, upgrade and install computer hardware and software.
- 2. Troubleshoot, diagnose, repair, upgrade and install server hardware and software.
- 3. Troubleshoot, diagnose, repair, upgrade and install networking equipment. This includes all LAN, WAN, Router and Switch troubleshooting, diagnostics and configuration.
- 4. Assist and instruct students, teachers and staff with software problems.
- 5. Communicate with vendors or vendor tech support when needed.
- 6. Produce technical documentation of tasks.
- 7. Prioritize, schedule and record multiple tasks as they arise and as assigned by the local or ISD Director of Technology.
- 8. Attend ISD and local technology meetings as requested.
- 9. Keep personal knowledge set current with respect to technology.
- 10. Pursue and maintain MS and/or Novell certifications.
- 11. Other reasonable duties as requested by the supervisor.
